In the women's all events, after the conclusion of 24 games, Prathima won the gold medal with 4351 pinfalls. Tamil Nadu's Sabeena Saleem took the silver and Nicole Campbell the bronze. In the men's all events, Delhi's Dhruv Sarda edged out his father and teammate Harshvardhan Sarda to take the gold medal. Girish Gaba of Karnataka clinched the bronze. Karnataka retained the overall title by winning four gold, one silver and four bronze medals to accumulate 33 points and registered a comfortable win over nearest rivals Delhi.
