In this tournament 234 boys and 39 girls participated from various colleges all over India. JIRS students were the youngest participants of the above tournament and the following students participated in this prestigious tournament.

These Boys are first time participating in out side tournaments; Rakesh played better and reached Quarter finals losing to Dikshit by 129/164 points. Karishma and Jaydevi performed excellently and reached finals by defeating Pavithra D M of CMS (score 136/123) and Ashwini J of SBMJCE (score 123/117) respectively.

In the finals both of our school girls played and Karishma defeated Jaydevi (score 147/128) to win the championship. Karishma and Jayadevi were awarded with a trophy and prize money of Rs 5000 and runner up trophy with prize money of Rs. 3000 respectively. Jayadevi was adjudged as the best player awarded with a Reebok wrist watch. Both our school girls scored the highest average score in a block of 2 games of the day and won Rs 1000 each.

On a day when fortunes fluctuated, Supreeth D. Nagraj of Ants Animation Institute, Bangalore and Karishma Gulecha of Jain International Residential School claimed the tenpin bowling titles in the boys' and girls' categories respectively in the Aaspire Vie 2011 Inter-Collegiate festival at Star City on Sunday.

In the final knockout play-off, Supreeth defeated Deepak Mehta of Shree Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College 194-136 to take the title, while Karishma defeated fellow collegian Jayadevi 142-119 to finish on top. Dikshit of SBRRMFGC from Mysore took the third spot in the boys' category, while Pavithra of CMS took third place on the girls' side.

Overnight leader Prajwal S.D. of Shree Bhagwan Mahaveer Jain College lost narrowly to Deepak Dugar of CMS 119-124, while Jatin Dodia of Jain Management School lost meekly to title winner Supreeth 141-199. The winners in both the categories took home a cash prize of Rs 5000 each, while the first and second runners up won Rs 3000 and Rs 2000 respectively. Prajwal SD of SBMJC was adjudged the Best Player in the boys' category while Jayadevi of JIRS was adjudged the Best Player in the girls' category, based on their total pinfall in the qualifying rounds.
